misinformation in media and politics) and, later on, the exploration of deep uncertainty and unshakeable faith in *Doubt*.



PLAYWRIGHT BIO



MARVIN NEIL SIMON (1927–2018) is widely regarded as one of the most successful, prolific and performed playwrights in theatre history. He wrote more than 30 plays and nearly the same number of screenplays (mostly film adaptations of his plays). Some of his works include: Barefoot in the Park, The Odd Couple, Sweet Charity, Plaza Suite, Last of the Red Hot Lovers, I Ought to be in Pictures, Lost in Yonkers, Fools, Brighton Beach Memoirs, Biloxi Blues, and Laughter on the 23rd Floor. His style ranged from farce to romantic comedy to more serious dramatic comedy. Overall, he received 17 Tony nominations and won three awards. In 1966, he had four successful productions running on Broadway at the same time, and in 1983 he became the only living playwright to have a New York theatre, the Neil Simon Theatre, named

in his honor. In 1988, Rumors opened on Broadway and ran for 535 performances.

For example, there's the career-focused partnership of Ken and Chris, or the fiery chemistry between Lenny and Claire, in which we witness the entanglements of love and marriage in all its messy glory.

I'm delighted to have worked with this talented group of artists in bringing *Rumors* to our stage. With it, we celebrate the absurdity of life, the strength of love, and the power of laughter—all resonating now as much as it did when it premiered in 1988. So sit back, embrace the comedy, cherish the relationships, and revel in the charm of Neil Simon's beloved romp!


