





# DRAMATURG'S NOTE

BY SYNTH MANUFI

Lauren Gunderson and Margot Melcon came up with the idea for *Miss Bennet: Christmas at Pemberley* on a road trip together in 2014. It is a show that is both practical—all theatre companies need good holiday shows—and different: it is rooted in the complications of being part of a family made up of dynamic women and what it means to support one another. It premiered in 2016 and has since become a popular holiday production in regional theaters across the United States.

Gunderson and Melcon took on a big responsibility in expanding the Jane Austen world, as this show is a sequel to the iconic novel *Pride and Prejudice*. You do not need to know the Bennet family lore in order to enjoy this wonderful holiday show, but if you're curious, here's what went down.

The novel centers around the Bennet family, particularly Elizabeth Bennet, the intelligent and witty second eldest daughter, and her evolving relationship with the wealthy and aloof Mr. Fitzwilliam Darcy. Set in early 19th-century England, the story explores themes of social class, marriage, morality, and misunderstandings.

The Bennet family has five daughters, and Mrs. Bennet is determined to marry them off to wealthy men to secure their futures. When the wealthy and eligible Mr. Bingley moves into the neighborhood, he quickly becomes smitten with the eldest Bennet daughter, Jane. At the same time, Mr. Darcy, Bingley's reserved and seemingly proud friend, initially snubs Elizabeth, leading her to form a negative opinion of him.

Elizabeth is further prejudiced against Darcy when she hears rumors about his mistreatment of George Wickham, a charming but unethical officer. As the story progresses, Darcy proposes to Elizabeth, but she rejects him due to her misconceptions about his character. However, Darcy later proves his true nature by helping Elizabeth's family in a time of crisis and revealing the truth about Wickham's deceit.

Through a series of misunderstandings and revelations, Elizabeth comes to recognize Darcy's integrity and kindness, while Darcy learns to overcome his pride. In the end, Elizabeth and Darcy fall in love and marry, as do Jane and Bingley.

## THE HISTORY OF CHRISTMAS

Christmas is often celebrated as the most wonderful time of the year, filled with gift-giving, advent calendars, caroling, and festive decorations like trees, garlands, and wreaths. Its history is long and varied, with the first recorded mention of Christmas dating back to the 2nd century. Christmas traditions, both new and old, converged in early 19th-century England, as seen in *Miss Bennet: Christmas at Pemberley.* 

In 17th-century England, Puritans condemned Christmas, viewing it as a Catholic invention. The holiday was even banned in 1647 following the English Civil War but restored in 1660. By the 19th century, authors like Charles Dickens helped shape Christmas into the family-centered, charitable holiday we recognize today. His works, along with the Oxford Movement in the Church of England, popularized Christmas services and the spirit of generosity.

The introduction of the Christmas tree came to Britain via Queen Charlotte in the early 1800s, later popularized by Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, spreading throughout the country by 1841.

There have been numerous film and TV adaptations of Jane Austen's work, especially *Pride and Prejudice* and *Sense and Sensibility*. But the Austen fandom goes much further than this. There is a pattern of modern women being placed in a Jane Austen world like the TV show *Lost in Austen* and *Austenland*. There are also movies like *Clueless* and *Bridget Jones's Diary* that take the main plots of Jane Austen novels and translate them to modern times. These few examples do

not even scratch the surface of all the Austen adaptations and fanfictions out there. What is the enduring appeal of Jane Austen's works? On the Fandom.com website, where fans can fill out their own research on any fandom you can think of, fans have stated that "Her realism, biting irony, and social commentary have gained her historical importance amongs scholars and critics."

Austen's work offers keen insights into human nature, timeless themes, and skillful storytelling, which resonates across generations. Her novels explore themes that are as relevant today as they were in her time, such as love, marriage, social status, and personal growth. Her focus on individual desires versus societal expectations creates a tension that readers across different eras can relate to.






